This 35 000 acre (14 000 hectare) property lies cupped in the palm of the "Sneeuberg" Mountain Range, the second highest range in South Africa.

From the bush thickets and riverine areas to the plateau grass plains with the backdrop of the majestic mountains that make every game drive a breathtakingly beautiful experience.

ACCOMMODATION

Camdeboo Manor is a Cape Dutch-style manor house dating from the early 1800s, with a large lounge and dining area, both with fireplaces, and leading to outdoor terraces, as well as four luxurious en-suite rooms with air-conditioning, under-floor heating and telephone. There is an African boma and a full-length swimming pool, and satellite TV is available in the lounge. The cosy **Honeymoon Suite** is situated nearby but with complete privacy in the beautifully restored old stone Gatehouse. **Courtyard Manor** dates from the late 1700s and has four luxurious suites, as well as an open plan living and dining area with a fireplace and satellite TV. There is an outdoor dining area, a full-length swimming pool and wrap-around patio. Built in the early 1900s, **Hillside Manor** is ideal for families or small groups, with its three beautifully appointed en-suite rooms, and open plan living and dining area leading to the terrace and full-length swimming pool. There is a fireplace and satellite TV in the lounge, and the lodge boasts a dedicated ranger, as well as a private game-viewing vehicle.

DIRECTIONS

Departing from Port Elizabeth, travel on the R75 which passes Uitenhage, continue on the R75 until you get to the R63 turn-off on your right to Pearson and Somerset East. Continue for 5km at which point you will see our signage followed by the turn-off on the left at the Petersburg Road, and follow the Mount Camdeboo sign posts to Reception.

TRANSFERS

Air or Road - Transfers from Port Elizabeth can be organised upon request.
